1. Attendance Policy:

during the institute timing 8.45 am to 4.45 pm. While using the laboratory facility prior approval must be taken from the Head of the Department. HoD will depute one instructor who will accompany the students during the laboratory timing. No student will be allowed to use the laboratory facility alone.

If any student wants to use the laboratory facility on Saturday/Sunday or after institute hours then he/she has to pay Rs. 50 per hour. 50% of this collection will be paid as honorarium to concerned supervisor.

3. Subjects offered by the department

As CIET is affiliated to Punjab Technical University, subjects offered by the Electronics & Communication Engineering department are as per PTU guidelines.

4. Student Training

Students undergoing B.Tech course in Electronics & Communication Engineering department have to complete three training during the whole 4 year course.

- A) Workshop Training will be imparted in the Institution at the end of second semester for 04 weeks duration for Six hours per day and six days a week or 05 weeks duration for Six hours per day and five days a week. Industrial tour will also form part of this training.
- B) There shall be an industrial training of 06 weeks duration in reputed industries at the end of 4th semester. The marks for this training will be included in the 5th semester.
- C) 6-month Industrial Training in 7th / 8th Semester depending upon the institute rules.

5. Teaching Load of faculty

Minimum teaching load including theory, tutorial and practical lectures will be as follows:
